God's Plan:

- D- Do : Pray- admit that you've done wrong (I have sinned) Ask God to forgive you and help you to change your behavior (repent) Believe Jesus died for you and rose from the grave Invite Jesus to live in and through you

Who said that you should be baptized?

Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Matthew 28:19-20

Following Jesus in baptism:

Once you have become a child of God, you should be baptized!

Being baptized is the first way you show your obedience to Jesus.

Being baptized tells everyone that you are now God's child and that you want to obey him

Is Baptism the way to Heaven?

NO! A relationship with Jesus is how we get to heaven. Baptism is an act of obedience.

Prayer

Prayer is talking and listening to God. You can talk to him at church, at school, at homeany time, any place! Set aside a special time each day to talk to Jesus.



Fellowship

Fellowship is believers doing things together. "They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer." Acts 2:42



Bible Study

Worship

Sing praises to God! Listen to Christian music, join children's choir, join in praise during the worship service. "Enter his gates with thanksgiving ans enter his courts with praise." Psalm 100:4



Service

We are to help others in our church and community. There is power in love!

Communion (Lord's Supper) is a special time to remember that Jesus died for us. His body was broken (nailed to the cross) and his blood was poured out for us.
